Each year, AIFL bestows its Partners for Democracy award upon distinguished individuals and organizations who have meaningfully supported the ongoing friendship between the United States and Israel. The award honors successful efforts to cultivate and strengthen the relationships, bonds and mutual respect that is shared by the people of both countries. This award has been bestowed on a long list of distinguished individuals including George Schultz, Bernard Lewis, Henry Kissinger, Michael Bloomberg, Lester Crown, Nir Barkat, Shari Arison, Chemi Peres, Al Schwimmer, Sami Segol, Mortimer Zuckerman, Yossi Vardi, Stanley Fisher, President George W. KENNETH J. BIALKIN LEADERSHIP AWARD

The Kenneth J. Bialkin Award for Leadership, established in 2020, recognizes leading figures who have stood at the forefront of business, politics, and innovation, with an emphasis on promoting better relations between the United States and Israel. The late Mr. Bialkin, former President of AIFL, had always believed that leaders are at the forefront of history and commercial success. His passion for Israel, its people and the state, and the nurturing of the bonds between the people of the State of Israel and the United States were at the basis of his efforts for introducing Israeli companies to the U.S. Capital markets, functioning as a fundamental lever in growing the Israel technology industry to its world leading status. AIFL awards each year the Kenneth J. Bialkin Award for Leadership, to a recognized business leader, who, through their organization, has led efforts for the promotion of commercial activity between the United States and Israel.

HERBERT TENZER LIFETIME ACHIEVEMENT AWARD

In the AIFL Certificate of Incorporation, dated March 8, 1971, our founders stated that the AIFL will: “promote, foster and develop mutual friendship and understanding between the people of the United States of America, the People of the State of Israel, and of other countries of the world through the interchange of cultural, educational, religious, artistic, scientific and economic knowledge and ideas or through such other means as may accomplish such purpose, including the proffer of hospitality and assistance to visitors to our country and travelers abroad ...”. The Herbert Tenzer Lifetime Achievement Award was established in 2005 to recognize the individuals who best exemplify the principles and values he believed in, and who, through their contribution to the America-Israel Friendship League, have promoted the shared values of both democracies.
